NOSA – the Nordic Aerosol Society – arranges the Nordic Aerosol Symposium in Helsingør November 15th-16th, 2012 at the conference center LO-skolen. We invite all aerosol scientists in the Nordic countries as well as world-wide to participate in this symposium. The conference language will be English. The special focus of the symposium is

You are invited to submit a one-page abstract according to the guidelines given in the Abstract Template which can be downloaded from the symposium web page. Please also fill out the abstract classification form.

The deadline for the registration and abstract submission is September 27th 2012.

The conference fee is 3000 DKK (~400 EUR), single room accomodation.

Students pay a reduced fee of 2500 DKK (~335 EUR), single room accommodation and 2200 DKK (~300 EUR) double room accommodation. See the symposium webpage for information on how to pay.

The fee includes accommodation for one night (Nov. 15th) proceedings, food and refreshments during the symposium, and the conference dinner on the evening of Thursday November 15th. An online registration form can be found on the symposium web page.
